Through May of this year we experienced a decline in revenue and net profit verses last year. Key components to the decline are lower event sales in the bar and restaurant. We are monitoring our cash closely but as stated in previous reports, the board is not looking to pay off long term debt since this would require the Club to access our line of credit much earlier in the year paying more interest than what we saved in lowering our long term debt. We have reduced our loan term debt by \$55,000 since May last year. We still have capital

improvements, expenditures and repairs that are required and meeting those demands requires available cash. We appreciate members bringing guests to the Club, promoting membership, and enjoying the SCC bar and restaurant. We also appreciate your timely monthly payments back to the Club.
