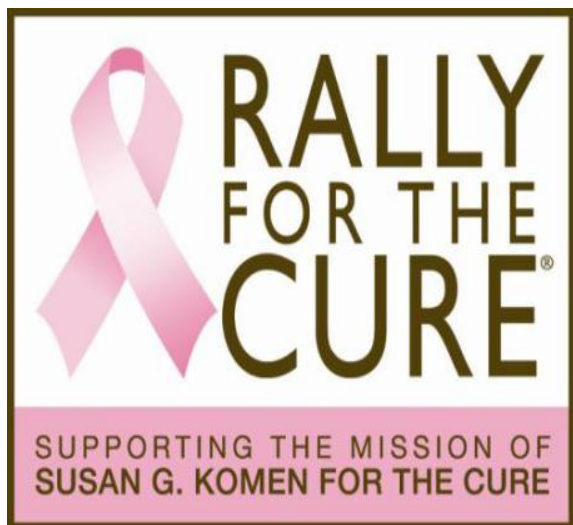
June 10 and June 24 will be the next meetings of the ladies group. We hope to see you there.
