**RULES: !. GROUNDING YOUR CLUB IN A HAZARD:** You cannot ground your club in a hazard. Practice Swings may be taken in a Hazard as long as you don't touch the ground, sand or water with your club. The top of the grass may be touched during a practice swing. The penalty incurred is loss of the hole in Match Play and a two shot penalty in stroke play. **2. ACCIDENTALLY MOVING YOUR BALL.** There is a one stroke penalty for accidentally moving your ball and it must be replaced in its original position before hitting. There is another one stroke penalty for hitting the ball from the wrong place if it is not replaced. There is no penalty for accidentally moving the ball when on the tee.

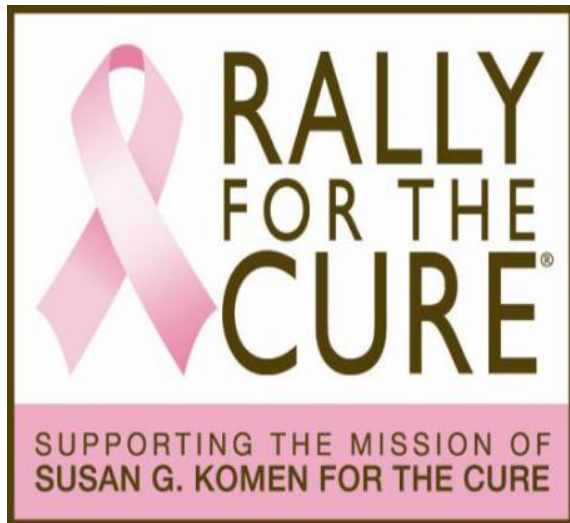
#### LADIES AUXILIARY
