First of all, it took a long time for the course to wake up and for things to start growing. This in turn caused a delay in the course healing up from any winter damage. Next, all the rain we received in May not only made it next to

impossible to keep up with the mowing it possibly hindered root development. This could cause us to water more often during the hot summer months.

The odd weather has also made it difficult to complete our chemical and fertilizer applications. Most of the applications can't be done in the rain. When we did get a nice day the course is filled with golfers that have been anxiously awaiting a good day to golf. This has caused us to make some applications when the course is relatively busy. I apologize if we interfered with anyone's game. It has been difficult to keep up with the mowing as well. When we do get a good day I have all the crew mowing. This causes us to get behind on string trimming and other tasks such as changing cups. Now that school is out for the summer this will be much less of an issue.

With the summer help coming soon we will start various small projects around the course. We will be doing our normal tree work as well as edging sand traps. We will also be adding lots of sand to the traps. Some of the bunkers have become contaminated with soil from being washed out repeatedly over the years so we will dig them out and add fresh sand as needed. The summer is upon us and I hope for some "normal" weather that will make for better golf and golf course maintenance. Hope to see you on the course.
