### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

The first few months of the year are always difficult to effectively demonstrate how the year will go. That said, so far we are certainly off to a good start. Total assets and net equity of the club are up by approximately \$60,000 as compared to the same period. Gross profit in the bar and restaurant are ahead of last year during the same period by \$2300. Dues are flat, however with the improvement in weather we are hopeful to see continued improvement in our membership base. Total net profit is down by \$6,000 over the same period last year, however we had some expenses that were front loaded during the period. We have also now booked the generous \$20,000 stock donation received from Patricia Holtan. The board has not determined how to utilize these funds so they remain invested in the market.
