### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

The third quarter net revenue of 2012 looks much the same as the third quarter of 2011. The difference lies in the makeup of the revenue and expenses. For 2012 restaurant revenues are down \$22,000, bar revenues are down \$4,000 while greens fees are up

\$6,000, cart revenue is up \$12,000, and donations are up \$14,000. Restaurant revenues continue to decline primarily due to the number and size of events hosted by the club. The ability to host outdoor events with the landscaping changes and the addition of the outdoor patio should enhance opportunities to host more events going forward. Club staff are planning on increasing sales efforts in that regard. Donations were up primarily due to the fundraising campaign for the outdoor patio. Overall net expenses were up \$5,000 compared to 2011. This brings our net revenue position to roughly the same as last year at this time.
